The **INNOVATE** Program

Learn contemporary technical skills in life science or applied science – your choice! You will also complete a 12+ week project written as a scientific paper on a topic important to you.

The **IMPLEMENT** Program

A final program that supports advanced work with mentors from the local scientific community.
