## **Accessibility Details:**




**Projected Kaleidoscope-**Play surface and materials wheelchair accessible.

**Light Tables-** One of three tables at wheelchair height. Seating removable to allow for wheelchair access.



**Water Table-** Highest pool surface is fully wheelchair accessible. Lower areas allow for footplate clearance.

Slate Wall- Wheelchair accessible.





**Entrance Gate-** Wheelchair accessible sliding gate.

**General-** Exhibits in this area are built for developing gross motor development

### BUILD

**Activity Table-** Tabletop building activities on a table built at two heights, to accommodate both wheelchair users and non-wheelchair users together.

### CLIMB

**The Climber-** Three ground-level activities integrated into the Climber. These are: noodle forest, ball-drop and the pachinko ball drop.

### **EXPERIMENT**

**Activity Table-** Tabletop building activities on a low child-height tables.

## GENERAL

**Washroom-** Wheelchair accessible Change table with 400lbs. load capacity

**Nursing Room-** Wheelchair accessible Change table with 400lbs. load capacity.

**Stroller Parking-** Wonder is a stroller-free zone. If your child requires a stroller for mobility purposes, please use the wheelchair access door.
